



Reception: School reading books

- The children will be bringing home a reading book without text. They will be learning to turn the pages carefully and talk about the pictures and the story that they think might be happening. This is to increase confidence, help to develop positivity around reading and develop the key reading skill of looking carefully and talking about what they can see.
- Children will be expected to have three positive reading experiences each week. Initially this might be some of their school reading book, the whole book, a magazine or a bedtime story. We would like parents to record each time your child reads in their Reading Record, this only needs to be a date and any quick notes you might like us to see.
- Reading Records need to be in school on a Friday to be checked. The box for Reading Records is kept between Holly and Maple Base.
- Books can be put in the box to be changed any day of the week if you have read it three times.
- Thank you for your support, reading at home makes a significant difference to their rates of progress.
