

## Marpool Holiday Club

A number of staff are employed by the school and are based and line managed at Marpool Primary School on 52 week contracts, so are available to support families and children throughout the school term and holiday periods offering targeted alternative provision, with the purpose of addressing dispositions and attitudes to learning; unpacking some of the barriers to fully inclusive learning.

During holiday time we offer a number of day courses which are run for children including a range of activities such as; sports, crafts, cooking and team games.

These programs are used to help support childrens' self esteem and wellbeing leading to a positive impact on pupils behaviour and outcomes.

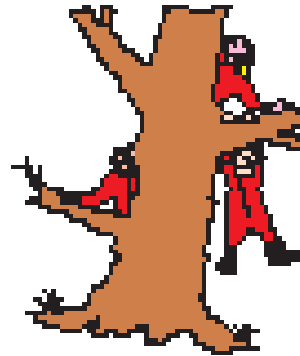
Alongside these activities the children have the option to support the animal care at the school.

## Small Animal Care

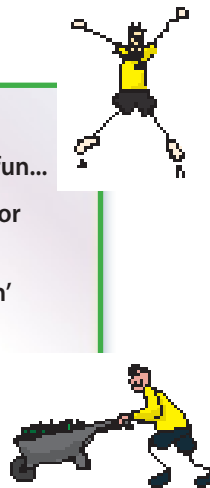
This is a session looking at and taking care of our school animals. This is designed to develop empathy and emotional language in a nurturing environment.

Working from our Community Cafe children will enjoy a range of creative activities offered by the staff. They will get stuck into all sorts of fun and may well bring home the odd artistic creation!

## Team games

Children will join in with lots of activities which will include team building, fire lighting, cooking and forest exploration. Programs and activities are specifically designed to meet each group's needs.

## De-brief

Each day will end with a de-brief of positives and negatives and a celebration of the achievements for the day.

## Days

The choice is yours; you can book your child in for a day at a time or more. Places are limited to 24 a day for children from Nursery to Year 6. Please book online using our school money system.



## Costings

Children can book on to our holiday club at a cost of £15 per day. Each day runs from 9.00am to 3.00pm. Parents will have the opportunity to arrive at 3.00pm.

## Support for Parents

A Parent Support Worker is also available for bridging that gap between school and home. They can come in and give practical advice and help about home life, government support, diet, and signpost to specific support organisations.



## Covid 19 conditions

We will continue to follow all of the school guidelines that have been put in place to keep staff and children safe. Holiday club will act as its own bubble and will have a maximum number of 24 places. Staff will maintain social distancing with the children and follow all hygiene measures that have been put in place. Places will not be offered to those not attending Marpool School.
